

EMERGING WOMEN LEADERS PROGRAMME



The **Ananta Aspen Centre** is launching a unique programme that combines mentoring and coaching with reflective dialogue-based seminars for generation of emerging women leaders in the 27-35 years age group. The intent is to support the journey of young women particularly from Tier 2 and Tier 3 cities in India, to professional and personal success through a strong foundation of self-belief, enlightened introspection and a spirit of collaboration.

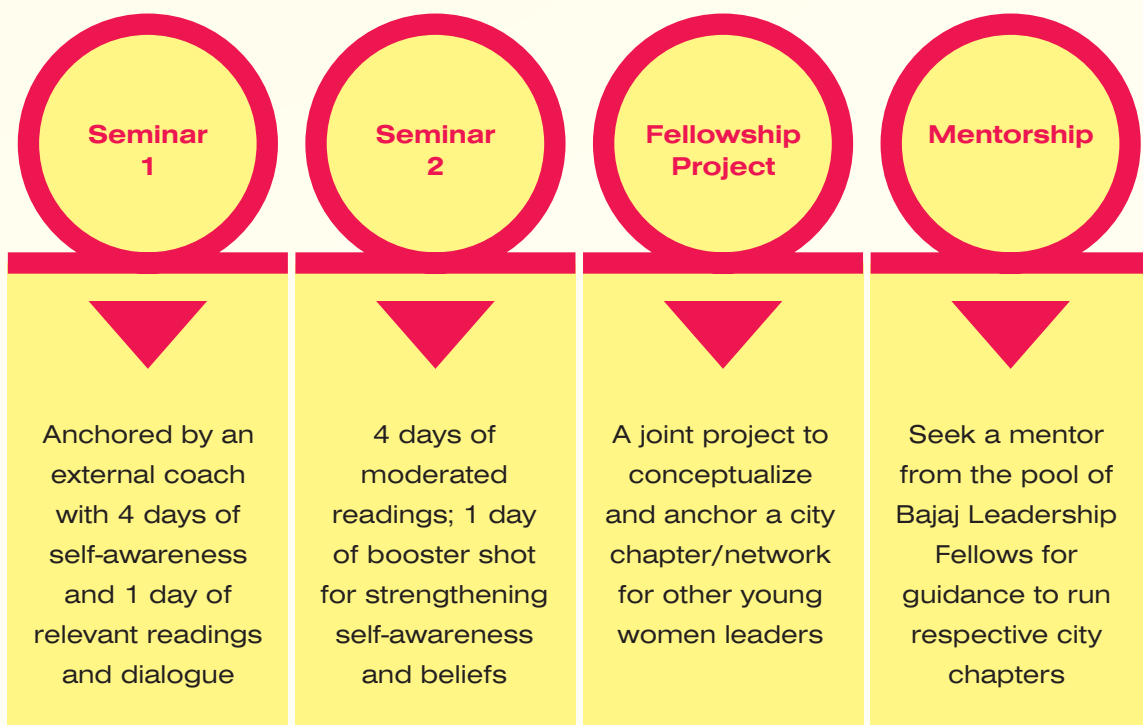
OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME

The Emerging Women Leaders Programme will take a carefully selected group of young women with leadership potential through a series of transformative coaching experiences and dialogue-based sessions to:

- Establish self-awareness; overcome limiting self-beliefs
- Equip themselves with tools and resources to accomplish leadership goals
- Guide their process of inquiry in developing a values-based leadership DNA
- Provide a platform for collaborative support for each other's life goals and ambitions

PROPOSED PROGRAMME DESIGN

The programme is designed for young women leaders who are at the cusp of leadership positions. It would nudge them to acknowledge their core beliefs and barriers, explore possibilities beyond their comfort zone, reflect on how they can significantly transform the course of their organizations, communities and cities. The Leadership Programme would have 4 components:



SEMINAR STRUCTURE

The programme would have 2 on site residential seminars spread over 12 months for a duration of 5 days 4 nights each. The first of these seminars will be held in March 2018.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

The candidates should be:

- Between the ages of 27–35 years
- From a Tier 2 / Tier 3 town
- One who is committed to participating in the residential seminars spread over 12 months.
- Someone who is at the cusp of leadership positions in Industry/Non Profit/ Arts or Young Entrepreneurs with at least a 5 year professional track record
- One who has the willingness to be fully present, authentic, vulnerable and willing to listen to differing points of view with an open mind and heart.



SEEKING NOMINATIONS FOR THE INAUGURAL CLASS

There is no cost involved for participants to be part of this Fellowship - just a commitment of time to attend the entire period of the residential seminars and commitment to take up a Fellowship project. Please note that there is a selection process involved to select a class of 25 emerging women leaders and nominations do not guarantee a confirmed seat.
