

Discover the leader within THE ASPENJUNIOR FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME

- Ananta Aspen Centre and The Shri Ram School together offer a unique leadership programme for students of classes 9–12.
- This one-of-a-kind programme uses The Aspen Institute's unique pedagogy to move students from thought to action, and from success to significance, thereby helping them discover the leader within.









The Programme

The Programme is centred around **Socratic Dialogue**, which explores personal values with the help of literature from around the world and across the ages. Each text presents challenges and asks students to articulate and explore their values and their leadership styles. Socratic Dialogue is the core of the Aspen Institute's Leadership Programmes, conducted around the world for over 70 years. This core is buttressed with theatre and experiential learning to help put their ideas into practice, communication skills to encourage clarity of thought, and team building and adventure sports to challenge their boundaries.

Objectives of the Programme

- Help students grow emotionally, intellectually and socially.
- Introduce leadership skills.
- Build appreciation for diversity in viewpoints.
- Discover personal ethics and valuesbased leadership.
- Inculcate respect for society, business, science & environment.
- Prepare them for the Fellowship of Valuesbased Leaders.

A Unique Values-Based Leadership Programme

- Only programme which has Aspen trained and certified moderators.
- Only programme where a student graduates as an Aspen Junior Fellow.
- All aspects of the programme are continually enriched with the Aspen Global curriculum.

Leadership Venture

As part of the leadership programme, the student will be required to initiate a project (venture). This venture should make significant changes in their respective communities. Students will write a short Project Proposal during the programme with the following details:

- Name of the venture.
- What will the venture do.
- Who/what will it benefit and how.
- How will it be measured.
- Does it meet the criteria for ventures laid out in the descriptor.
- Why is the venture worthy of the Leadership School.

The student will then provide regular updates as the venture is implemented.

Text-based Socratic Dialogue

Students will read, reflect and discuss thought provoking readings on the issues of Leadership:

- 1. The Challenge of Leadership
- 2. The Promise of Leadership
- 3. The Good Society
- 4. The Possibility of Heroism
- 5. The Meaning of Life

Team building and adventure sports like rafting, zip-lining and trekking develop bonding, coordination and leadership skills in a safe environment.

TSAALS Handbook

Participants will be provided a Student Handbook four weeks before the Programme. The participants must read the entire Handbook before the Programme.

The Process

Travel & Logistics

- TSAALS is a two-week long offsite residential programme.
- Students must be vaccinated.
- The group will drive up to Camp Panther beyond Rishikesh on 24th May 2024.
- Closing ceremony will be held at The Shri Ram School, Gurgaon.

Accommodation, Food & Safety

Accommodation: The selected location has spectacular scenic beauty, is safe and creates

an inspirational environment for learning. **Food**: Care is taken to provide food that is nutritious, wholesome and tasty. The menu has a combination of vegetarian and non-vegetarian items. Fruits are served regularly and nimbu-paani or other fruit-flavoured drinks are available through the day to keep the participants hydrated. Mineral water is available on all sites and locations.

Safety: Right from the time a child is handed over to us, they are our responsibility. We have a well-trained and certified team; the adult to child ratio is 1:5. There are six faculty members in addition to administrative staff in camp. A resident nurse is available for the duration of the Camp and a doctor is available on call.

Admission & Selection

Criteria for Admission

- Students from grades 9 12 are eligible for the programme.
- The student should be academically inquisitive with strong record of extracurricular activities.
- An overall performer and team player, ready for challenges.
- Should have good command over written and spoken English.



The theatre module is used to enhance self-confidence and emotional intelligence. The students will write a play on values-based leadership to "experience" leadership challenges. <u>Community visit to a</u> children's home sensitizes the students to social issues, and to an environment marked by scarcity and inequities.



Admission Process

The first round of selection will involve the following:

- Answer to the question: "A newspaper article has been written about you 10 years from now. You have been extremely successful. What do you want the article to say? (Not more than 300 words)."
- 2. A recommendation letter from a teacher/ school administrator/guidance counsellor.

Cost of the Programme

Early Bird, till 31st March 2024 : Rs 1,25,000. 31st March 2024 onwards : Rs 1,35,000.
